BFX Furniture is an Australian business specialising in the design, manufacture and supply of commercial, office and education furniture.



In 2009, BFX pioneered the development of ‘flexible learning furniture’ at the request of the Queensland Government to better cater for the wide range of teaching and learning styles. Today, we’re supplying innovative furniture solutions like this to every Australian State and abroad.

BFX is a bigger business today than it was even 10 years ago, but we still pride ourselves on providing the same personal service and quality products you expect from a small, family business.

Our people

With a growing workforce of nearly 300 staff, BFX has an extended sales team based all over metropolitan and regional Australia as well.

BFX is still based where it all started, at Yandina on Queensland's Sunshine Coast.

Nestled at the base of Mount Ninderry (Gubbi Gubbi/Kabi Kabi Country), our 24,000m² modern manufacturing and supply facility is the nucleus of our business and home to BFX Headquarters.

At BFX we support hundreds of families locally and throughout metropolitan and regional Australia through direct employment. We support many more through our support of Australian suppliers, sub-contractors, small and medium enterprises (SME's).

BFX is 100% Australian owned and operated and we are proud of the contribution our business makes to the community.

Our environment

BFX Furniture has an enduring commitment to the sustainability of our products and practices.

We achieve this through ethical sourcing and continuous improvement in our use of raw materials, energy and resources, waste minimisation and recycling, and furniture design that ensures our products are fit-for-purpose and built to last.

Our manufacturing and supply headquarters is solar powered and ‘carbon neutral’. Partnerships with suppliers Laminex, SAPAR and JJ Richards see our board, metal and cardboard waste recycled, while plastic packaging is minimised, and polystyrene has been almost completely removed from our supply chain.

BFX has an unblemished record of compliance with local, state, and federal legislation and Australian standards. We use an Environmental Management System (ISO 14001), independently audited and certified, to continuously improve our business’ production systems and performance.
